

ORDINANCE 957

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE SPECIFIC USE FOR THE KINKAID SCHOOL, PERMITTING A SIGN HOLDER FOR THE KINKAID SCHOOL AS PROVIDED UNDER SECTION 74-123 (4) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PINEY POINT VILLAGE, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION PURSUANT TO SECTION 74-128 PURSUANT TO CONDITIONS UNDER SECTION 74-129 OF CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PINEY POINT VILLAGE; PROVIDING A PENALTY OF AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,000.00 FOR EACH DAY OF VIOLATION OF ANY PROVISION HEREOF; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

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BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PINEY POINT VILLAGE, TEXAS:

Section 1. Section 74-122 is hereby amended to provide for a specific use permit for a sign holder on the grounds of The Kinkaid School so long as said sign conforms with the attached design guidelines and Section 74-280 (4) of the code of ordinances of the City of Piney Point Village, so long as said sign holder is not erected within 10 feet of any street right of way line and is located on the private grounds of The Kinkaid School.


Section 2. Any person who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be fined in an amount not to exceed \$2,000.00. Each day of violation shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 3. In the event any clause phrase, provision, sentence, or part of this Ordinance or the application of the same to any person or circumstances shall for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair, or invalidate this Ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the City Council of the City of Piney Point Village, Texas, declares that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any such part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, whether there be one or more parts.


