

**ORDINANCE 970**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PINEY POINT VILLAGE, TEXAS, DECLARING THE UNOPPOSED CANDIDATES FOR ALDERMAN POSITION NOS. 1, 2, AND 5, ELECTED; PROVIDING THAT THE MAY 12, 2007 GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION SHAL NOT BE HELD; CONTAINING OTHER PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE SUBJECT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES INCONSISTANT OR IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to City of Piney Point Village Ordinance 969, passed and approved February 26, 2007, a general municipal election was ordered to be held on May 12, 2007 for the purpose of election three officials of the City, to wit: Aldermen Position Nos. 1, 2, and 5; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to said Ordinance 969 and Section 143.007 of the Texas Election Code, the deadline for filing applications for a place on the ballot of the City's General Election has expired; and

**WHEREAS**, the Assistant to the City Administrator, in accordance with Section 2.056 of the Texas Election Code, has certified to the City Council in writing that John Ebeling is unopposed for election to the office of Alderman Position 1, Julie G. Goodall is unopposed for election to the office of Alderman Position 2, and Randhir Sahni is unopposed for election to the office of Alderman Position 5; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council hereby finds and determines that each candidate whose name is to appear on the ballot in said election is unopposed, and no proposition is to appear on the ballot for such election;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PINEY POINT VILLAGE, TEXAS:**

**Section 1.** The facts and matters set forth in the preamble of the Ordinance are hereby found to be true and correct.

**Section 2.** In accordance with Section 2.053(a) of the Texas Election Code, the following unopposed candidates are hereby declared duly elected to the respective offices shown:

**Alderman Position 1: John Ebeling**

**Alderman Position 2: Julie G. Goodall**

**Alderman Position 5: Randhir Sahni**

**Section 3.** Pursuant to Section 2.053(b) of the Texas Election Code, the general election heretofore called and ordered by City of Piney Point Village, Texas, Ordinance 969 for the 12<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2007, shall not be held and is hereby cancelled.

**Section 4.** The Assistant to the City Administrator is hereby directed to cause a copy of this Ordinance to be posted on Election Day, same being May 12, 2007, at the polling place that would have been used in such election.

**Section 5.** In the event any clause, phrase, provision, sentence, or part of this Ordinance or the application of the same to any person or circumstance shall for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair, or invalidate this Ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the City Council of the City of Piney Point Village, Texas, declared that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any such part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, whether there be one or more parts.


**Section 6.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent or in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict, hereby repealed.
